The Montessori Approach

The Montessori method of learning is renowned as one of the most innovative and intelligent teaching methods available for young children. It was created by Dr. Maria Montessori in 1907, who was a respected Italian physician, educator, and philosopher. Montessori's approach to the education of a child is unique in that it is based on the observation of the child and following his or her abilities and interests. MFMS Online has created a virtual methodology that adopts these principles.

Keeping You Informed

Our approach ensures we work in partnership with families to promote open communication for the mutual benefit of the child. We welcome parents to speak with teachers daily and will be available via e-mail or phone. MFMS Online also subscribes to the HiMama app which provides parents updates on your child's activities, as well as the weekly schedules sent directly to your email and smartphone.

Security

With MFMS Online, security is of utmost priority. Applying Zoom's inmeeting security capabilities, our virtual classrooms and tutoring sessions are secure, encrypted, locked, and password-protects. In addition, our policy ensures that videos must be turned on and participants are screened by a supervisor before attending sessions.

Virtual Classrooms

Designed by certified Montessori teachers, our virtual classrooms are created for children ages 16 months to 6 years, with the goal of preserving the continuity of learning while maintaining your child's daily structure.

MFMS Online's approach to education enable children the freedom to explore and learn, mostly through self-direction – a method that provides the child an opportunity to grow intellectually, physically, emotionally and cognitively.

Specialty Programs

Dance

This weekly class promotes a balanced physical and mental development of the child. It is also helps to build strength, flexibility, and confidence.

Yoga

Yoga class helps to encourage a balance between physical and spiritual development. Through a series of postures and breathing practices, yoga can help calm and refresh the body and mind.

Music

Music has many benefits such as building social skills, exposing children to different sounds from around the world, and raising everyone's spirits.

Karate
